As per our previous parish council meetings, we are in the slow process of carrying out repairs to all the broken windows. These repairs are highly specialised involving planning permission, an architect, conservation specialists and blacksmiths, as well as glaziers. This is simply due to the nature of the building and the fact that it is B-listed. Needless to say, it is also an expensive operation (c£9,000). All being well, however, we hope to have all the broken/damaged windows repaired by the end of the summer. We shall keep you updated. You are very welcome to contribute towards the cost and your generosity is always greatly appreciated.
