## **CANMORE CHAPLAINCY FOR UNIVERSITY CATHOLICS**

### **Student Pilgrimage to Rome – March 2020**

Canmore Catholic Chaplaincy is pleased to announce the offer of a pilgrimage to Rome during the Spring Break of 2020 (16-20 March), led by Fr Galbraith. The pilgrimage would include the following:

- 4 nights B&B accommodation, near to the Vatican.
- All coach transfers (St Andrews to Edinburgh airport, Ciampino to Rome, excursions etc)
- 3 group meals in restaurants (so practically half-board)

- Daily Mass at various holy sites, including the tomb of St Peter
- A walking tour of the city, visiting various famous sites (Pantheon etc) and the tombs of saints (St Catherine of Sienna, St Ignatius etc)
- A visit to the catacombs and the four major basilicas of Rome
- Audience with Pope Francis in St Peter's square
- Spiritual renewal and general good fun!

The cost will be around £400 (+£76 single room supplement), which DOES NOT include flights. Pilgrims would be required to book their own flights (departure: Edinburgh, Ryanair, 15:45 hours, 16 March 2020, Rome Ciampino; return 11:00 hours, 20 March. Price currently £130). Pilgrims may wish to book only a single flight and make their own plans of return after 20 March. Sign-up sheets at back of church if interested.
