### NEWS ITEMS

#### Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

#### Mass (booking)

Welcome back to Mass! Naturally, we have some restrictions at these times. Physical distance needs to be maintained, hands should be sanitised upon entry and leaving, and face coverings should be worn (we can provide you with one if you do not have one. Children under 5 do not have to wear one, nor those with respiratory problems). We do not anticipate any problems with numbers at Mass during the week. However, we need to restrict numbers at the Sunday Masses to 50 max in St James' (with overflow into the hall, live-feed) and 35 max in Crail.

In order to help us organise things safely and well for the Sunday Masses, it would be very helpful if parishioners/visitors book a place online in advance using the Eventbrite links below or by contacting the parish priest by phone/email. Please remember that people from the same household can sit on the same pew. If you are on your own, please sit near the wall to

allow room for another person at the other end of the pew.

For communion time, we advise anyone coming forward for Holy Communion to then exit the church through our sacristy/tea room and then re-enter the church through the front door for the final blessing. This will create a one way system which gets around the difficulty of only having one, central aisle in our churches.

Finally, please do not be offended if we simply cannot allow you in. However, we will do our very best to avoid this.

After consulting with Greyfriars Primary School, we hope to have the First Confessions of those who missed it because of lockdown on Saturday 3 October, 10am, St James'. Regarding First Communion, the Archbishop is keen that we proceed with these as soon as possible and certainly before Christmas. To this end, we have the option of either having all the children together with probably just their parents in attendance, or separating the children out into smaller groups with greater availability for family and friends to attend. To this end, Fr Galbraith has booked off the Saturday mornings of 10, 17, 24, 31 of October and 7 November. We would be grateful if the parents of these children were to contact the parish by email to suggest their preference. If for the latter option, it would probably just be a case of picking a preferred date on a first come, first served basis.
