#### Eventbrite Bookings for Mass

In a mild amendment to the Eventbrite booking system, we would be grateful if a separate booking were made, where possible, for each person and not just one per household. It's not that we need the information, as such, it is more to have an accurate idea of numbers. Numbers have been increasing of late and we are usually at capacity for the 11am and 5pm Masses - but not the vigil Mass and not quite the Crail Mass either. We would also be grateful if you have made a booking but cannot make it that you cancel the booking at your earliest convenience to allow others to take your place. How do i do that? Simple! Follow these instructions: 1. On your confirmation email, scroll down to the Order Summary 2. Click on the words "view and manage" in the line "View and manage your order online". 3. This will take you to your active Tickets. (Note: it may sometimes require you to log back into Eventbrite) 4. Click on the specific event you would like to cancel. 5. This will take you to the Order page for the specific event. Next, click the white "Cancel Order" button underneath the orange "Print Tickets" button. After clicking the "Cancel Order" button, your order will be cancelled and your spot cleared. St James' will receive an email notifying them of the cancellation.

### **Feast of St Margaret**

In addition to the morning Mass on the Feast of St Margaret, we intend to have Solemn Vespers at 5.10pm in St James' on Monday 16 November. This will include adoration and benediction.

### **November, month of the Holy Souls**

During the month of November we are encouraged to pray for our Faithful Departed and all the Holy Souls in Purgatory. We shall also pray for our dead at the end of each Mass. Prayer slips will be available at the back of the church, which can then be filled in and placed in the baskets that will be laid before the altars of our churches during the entire month.

### **Archdiocesan Diploma in Catechetics**

The Archdiocese is launching an online Diploma in Catechetics (Jan - Dec 2021) for laity involved in Catechetics/Faith Formation in the Archdiocese. It will consist of 6 modules of 6 classes and taught weekly in 45 minute lectures on Thursday evenings at 7:30pm. It will be taught by a variety of diocesan priests and laity and coordinated by Sr Anna Marie McGuan RSM. There will be a nominal cost of £100 per person (financial assistance is available).
