Clergy Moves – New Parish Priest of St James' and Chaplain to Canmore

As announced from the pulpit last week and available on social media etc, the Archbishop has decided to move Fr Galbraith, as of the first week of September, to become the Parish Priest of St Mary's, Bathgate. He will be replaced by the Right Rev Mgr Patrick Canon Burke who is currently Vicar General and Administrator of St Mary's Cathedral, Edinburgh. Canon Burke also happens to be a graduate of the University of St Andrews and previous President of the Catholic Society. He is very familiar with St Andrews

and surrounding East Neuk of Fife. Please do keep Fr Galbraith and Canon Burke in your prayers at this time.
