Chrism Mass: Date for the diary

The Chrism Mass this year is at 7pm on Tuesday 26 March in St Mary's Catheral, Edinburgh – when the Bishop is encouraged to gather with his priests and people in Holy Week for the blessing of the Holy Oils. There is a little list of car drivers at the back of the church in St James' on the noticeboard. Students are leaving at 4pm; others can leave at 5pm from St James'. If interested, please add your name to the list. Students are kindly requested to bring their academic gowns.

The Holy Triduum (Holy Week)

The Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday) is the celebration of the Paschal Mystery. Through the liturgy of these three days the Church remembers and makes present to us the suffering, death and resurrection of Christ from the dead. As such, it is the most important celebration of the Church's liturgical year. Please do make every effort to come to all three services and enter into the mystery of our faith, especially if you have a family. It is a wonderful thing to do.

N.B.: This year there are 3 adults being baptised, 2 being received into the Catholic Church through Confirmation and 4 baptised Catholics being Confirmed at the Easter Vigil. A number will have relatives and friends attending this Mass and so the Easter Vigil may be quite busy. The newly baptised/received and their families are welcome to join us, as is everyone, for an Easter party in Canmore after the Easter Vigil Mass.
